wherever I am my servants will be.

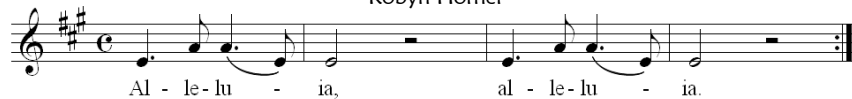
